Installation of Photovoltaic power generation System and Energy storage system to make our office more sustainable

At MatsukiyoCocokara & Co. (Head office: Bunkyo-ku, Tokyo, President and Representative Director: Kiyoo Matsumoto), we aim to reach net zero CO₂ emissions in our corporate group by FY2050, along with a milestone of reducing CO₂ emissions by 40% by FY2030 compared to FY2021. Our initiatives include installing photovoltaic power generation systems at stores and using renewable energy for electricity. To further accelerate these efforts and maintain office functions even in the event of severe disasters, we are pleased to announce that we have installed a photovoltaic power generation system and a power storage system at our Shin-Matsudo office.

In this initiative, we have adopted a power conditioner and a multi-energy storage platform, completely dedicated to private consumption, from a Japanese manufacturer, OMRON Social Solutions Co., Ltd. (Head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo, President and CEO: Katsuhiro Shikata, hereinafter referred to as "OSS").

Furthermore, through this installation, OSS will donate a portion of the installation cost to the "Solaputi Kids' Camp," which provides support to children battling serious illnesses through camp experiences.
